Setting And Connections:

1.Aerial set up

- Step 1: Connect the end (IEC- male) of attached coaxial cable to ANT/IN connector at the back of the TV or DVB-T tuner.
- Step 2: In the TV's setup menu, set the tuner mode to "Aerial" or "Air". Refer to the TV manual for detailed instructions.
- Step 3: In the TV's setup menu, set TV to "scan" for channels. This can sometimes be listed as auto-program, auto-scan, channel search or channel scan. Consult the TV manual for detailed instructions.
- Step 4: If reception is sporadic, try moving the aerial to another location and rescanning the TV.
- Step 5: Placing the aerial higher or close to/in a window may result in better reception. You must rescan whenever you move the aerial.

- 2. Aerial stand
- 3. Power adapter(DC 5V/200mA)
- 4. Transmitter (include CR2032 battery)

Two powered choices ① or ②
① Powered by DTV set-top box via coaxial cable (package attached)
② Powered via separate AC/DC adapter (package included)

Connected to TV through set top box

Note:

- 1.If you use a flat HDTV, pls go through your TV manual to make sure your TV is with builtin tuner for freeview.
- 2.TV reception depends on the distance from your home to the transmitting tower and the surrounding environments.

2.Doodbell set up

When aerial is done connected, the doorbell will be combined with aerial as following:

 $(\ensuremath{\texttt{IPress}}\xspace$ the auto-learning code button, then press the button on the Transmitter unit once, the

- aerial will sound to indicate that the transmitter works successfully with the
- receiver(aerial). The aerial can also work with maximum 5 Transmitters at the same time.
- OPress the volumn button to adjust the sound volume to be high, medium and low.

(3)Melody selector is available to choose 32 molodies.

NOTE: Aerial must be powered on to ensure doorbell working properly.
